I use these two equipment sets “at home” and “on the go”. The “On the go” set is affordable and expendable. It will not last long and will not give you a powerful light. Yet, it’s a great choice if you want to travel lite and have practical and expandable equipment. Of course, you can mix these setups too.

3 Light Sources  
2 ring lights front side  
1 table lamp behind  
Lapel Mic  
Smartphone 13 mp camera
